A one-day itinerary for Murray, Kentucky

- 8 a.m. Enjoy the complimentary breakfast at your hotel.
- 8:45 a.m. Warm up with a cinnamon roll flavored coffee at University Book & Bean. While there, browse the latest books and purchase some Murray State apparel.
- 9:30 a.m. Visit the Clara M. Eagle Art Gallery, a multi-level exhibition space featuring everything from student art to national juried shows. Admission is free.
- 10:30 a.m. Browse the Wrather West Kentucky Museum. On the National Register of Historic Places, the museum features exhibits that highlight Murray State University, Murray and the Jackson Purchase region. The museum also holds both permanent and changing exhibits.
- 12 p.m. Enjoy lunch at HRH Dumplin's, and whether you order a sandwich, salad, casserole or soup, make sure it comes with one of their oversized homemade rolls.
- 1 p.m. Drive downtown, park for free, and peruse the various unique shops, including Penique's, featuring three floors of gifts, home decor and kitchen accessories.
- 2 p.m. Take an adult beginner oil painting class at Gallery 109 & Fairbanks Studio, taught by Jennifer Fairbanks, a native Murray artist who lived in New York City for 11 years.
- 4 p.m. Stop by the Murray Convention & Visitors Bureau and pick up some information on Murray and the surrounding area, then back to the hotel for some rest and relaxation.
- 6 p.m. Have dinner at Jasmine and enjoy Thai food in a classic atmosphere. Try one of the many varieties of sushi.
- 7 p.m. See a play at Playhouse in the Park, with performances varying from American classics to fun shows.
